Practices begin for the Spring season the week of March 22, 2010. (Some older teams may begin practice the week before). The first game is anticipated to be played the first weekend in April. There will be no games played on Easter or Memorial day weekend.

Most games are played on Sundays from 1:00 - 5:00 PM. Girls' teams in the Under 8 and Under 10 age group will play games on Saturday mornings from 9:00 to Noon. Home games are played at the Sam Wise Sports Complex at the east end of Altoona on 8th Street SE. Under 6 will play in Altoona. Under 8 teams will play in Altoona and may travel. Under 10 teams will have up to four away games. Under 12 and Under 14 teams will have up to four away games with teams around the Greater Des Moines area (from Ames to Adel to Indianola to Pella).

Sign-up by January 15, 2010 and avoid paying late fees. Don't be one of the people who missed the deadline for the Spring 2010 season and his/her child couldn't play because teams were full.

Age Groups: Age on 7/31/09

Under 6 (U6)	4 and 5
Under 8 (U8)	6 and 7
Under 10 (U10)	8 and 9
Under 12 (U12)	10 and 11
Under 14 (U14)	12 and 13



GENERAL INFORMATION:

• Players may not indicate a Coach preference for a team.

- Under 6 through Under 10 will not be allowed to change age groups.
- Under 12 - 14 players requesting to play in an older age group should indicate that on the registration form. Your request may be denied based on your situation or if that age group has no openings. These requests will need to be approved by the Soccer Board. You may be asked to appear before the Board at one of our monthly board meetings.
- There are a limited number of scholarships available. All requests must be approved by the board.

BOARD MEETINGS:

The Altoona Youth Soccer Association is a volunteer organization. Board meetings are the third Tuesday of each month beginning at 7:30 PM at the Altoona Chamber of Commerce conference room. Check the website to verify the date and time of our meeting. All parents are encouraged to actively participate in our association by attending meetings or volunteering your time.

REFUNDS:

- For refund requests after sign-ups and prior to the first game, state the reason for your request along with the player's name and birthdate to the Altoona Youth Soccer Association mailing address listed above. Refunds will need to be approved by the Soccer Board.
- If players cannot be placed on a team, refunds will be issued.
